

How MøreRoyal is made®

During the manufacturing process, the materials undergo two different treatments. The timber is first pressureimpregnated, before being vacuum-dried in hot royal oil.


This can be compared to giving pressure-impregnated materials an additional 'raincoat' which protects against harsh weather conditions. We like to call this 'the royal treatment'... This is something that produces premium materials.

PRESSURE IMPREGNATION

First, the materials are pressure impregnated with an impregnating agent, which ensures effective protection against rot.

DRYING IN LINSEED OIL

The materials are then vacuum-dried for 6–8 hours in a linseed oil mix. This process forces moisture out of the wood, while hot oil penetrates 1–2 mm into the surface from all sides. The result is timber that is saturated and sealed on all surfaces. This form of oil sealing reduces moisture uptake, shrinkage and swelling, resulting in highly stable wood. Colour pigments can also be added to the oil under the same process. Once the materials have received their Royal treatment, they are ready for use.

Colours MøreRoyal®

COLOURS PATIO DECKING









MøreRoyal patio decking comes in three colours. The colours are transparent, giving the materials a rich surface and bringing out the grain of the wood.


There may be a slight variation in the colours due to heartwood, sapwood and knots absorbing different amounts of oil and pigment. This brings out the natural properties of the timber.




MøreRoyal grey is a warm grey tone that is rich and natural. Materials in grey will attain an increasingly natural grey colour as they weather.

When fresh, the grey colour may appear greenish or brown as a result of the royal impregnation. This will change as the materials weather, and the grey pigments become more prominent over time.





MøreRoyal brown is a warm and golden colour. With warm base tones, the colour fits beautifully into most environments.



MøreRoyal natural contains no added colour pigments. When fresh, the colour will appear golden. The materials then become grey over time, and they gain a grey and extremely beautiful patina as they weather.

Remember that areas under an overhang or in the shade will not react in the same way as surfaces that are directly exposed to sunlight.



COLOURS OVER TIME

The colours will fade as they are exposed to a harsh European climate. The final result is individual and there is no one-size-fits-all result, but all colours will appear more muted over time. Remember, however, that the oil is boiled into the wood and continues to protect the materials.

COLOUR CODES

MøreRoyal has transparent colours and no two decking surfaces will never be identical. Do you need tips on which NCS or RAL colours that are similar to MøreRoyal colours? We recommend seeking advice and guidance from your paint supplier as many factors can affect the final result.

To freshen up the colour, simply add a layer of clear MøreRoyal EXCLUSIVE patio oil. How to bring the colour pigments to life again.

This patio decking has a grooved and a smooth side. The grooved side is defined as the A side.

UNO - WITH GROOVES

UNO patio decking in MøreRoyal grey is single-sided patio decking that is laid with the grooved side up. Uno is pre-painted in a beautiful, transparent grey just as perfect for the contemporary home as for the holiday cottage. The grey colour will develop over time, becoming a lighter grey after a winter.



Do you prefer to lay the UNO decking with the smooth side up? This is also possible. The decking is sold as single-sided as so-called stream marks may occur during production. These marks will fade and even out over time.

So, grooved or smooth - the decision is yours.





AT HOME WITH MARIANNE STENSRUD



Building your dream home doesn't have to mean starting from scratch. Building something new is expensive, and more and more people redesign their current home and undertake a comprehensive renovation project instead. With a clear plan and a little creativity, it is entirely possible to create gold from grey stone.

THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME

"In recent years, we have completely renovated our home, including the outdoor areas. We spend a lot of time outdoors in our garden and wanted the same standard and style throughout the house," says Marianne.

This is a tip that shouldn't be ignored because a home is so much more than the sum of everything within the four walls of the house. Whereas in the past, people often built an oblong box along one of the four walls of

the house and called it a patio, they now take it a whole lot further. Outdoors is the new indoors, and time and effort is spent on taking outdoor spaces to the next level. It also means that the choice of materials is much more important than it was before.

"Choice of materials is about both design and properties," Marianne points out. "For our part, we wanted materials that matched the other choices we had made on and in the house. And although it may

be easy to forget this, patio materials also come in different designs, dimensions and colours.

Instead of picking the cheapest, it's well worth spending some time on your choices as the cheapest now may not be the cheapest in the long run, when you add up purchase price, maintenance and durability. Maintenance-friendly materials were simply a must here in the courtyard. Like so many others, we live busy lives and don't want to spend the short summer months here in Norway staining or replacing decking. We preferred to invest in quality so that we are able to enjoy ourselves with family and grandchildren around a large table overflowing with great food instead."

A PROJECT WITHOUT A DEADLINE

At Marianne and Torgeir's house, Marianne thinks up the design ideas while Torgeir puts these ideas into practice. Together they make up a good team, and the pair usually have a project on the go.


"You know, you really never finish. Luckily. It's only natural that we're constantly inspired and take our ideas home with us and use them in our own garden. But that doesn't mean that we do a complete renovation every five years. Small steps and adjustments are all that's needed for a little renewal," explains Marianne.

And Marianne and Torgeir have completed quite a few projects over the years, most of them using MøreRoyal, which has created a holistic and consistent outdoor space.

"Our outdoor space has simply received some well-deserved attention in recent years. Different zones have been established using decking, stairs and windbreaks. The colours of the materials were really crucial for us, and we have chosen grey decking combined with black laths and trellises. The natural colours 'settle' after they have been left for a while, which we think is very beautiful. And we have taken inspiration from the slatted elements in the kitchen, bathroom and front door which inform the ideas outside, so that the style is consistent throughout."

MARIANNE'S AND TORGEIR'S OUTDOOR SPACE

If you have plans to start work on your outdoor space this summer, start at one end and take it all 'one step at a time'. It often pays to view it as a marathon and not a sprint so that you are able to make adjustments along the way. But still, make an overall plan to start from so that you always keep your eye on the end goal.

MARIANNE'S TIPS:

1. Feel free to get started yourself, but do listen to experienced professionals

"There's a lot you can build yourself, but know your limitations. It's important that everything is of a high enough standard. That's why we chose to have a carpenter build all the scaffolding, but laid all the trellises and decking ourselves," says Marianne. "We were then confident that the groundwork was 100% OK. At the same time, our own labour reduced the total costs."


2. It takes time, but details count

"In our case, the decking was laid at 0.5 cm intervals with concealed fastenings. A lot of work, but the result is so much better when you don't see all the screw fastenings. We were a little unsure about choosing the interval between the decking boards, but we're very happy with 0.5 cm as this makes it easier to clean, sweep and hose down the decking."

Building an outdoor space with slabs and stairs that create different levels is another good tip.

Having everything on one level can quickly become monotonous. Also think about what the different levels and zones are going to be used for, and adapt the project to each individual purpose. How about a reading nook for those quiet moments or a sheltered area for sunbathing on those long-awaited, hot summer days?

"Take your surroundings as a starting point, and build the outdoor space around them," advises Marianne. "The land our house is on consists of several levels descending towards a stream at the end of the plot. This has resulted in our having to build a number of steps down to the



outdoor area, which breaks up the design compared to an outdoor area on a single level. We also have a roof, a small must in Nordic countries where the sun doesn't always play along, even though we would like to sit outside. By using the same type of materials in slightly different colours, the area has been given a clean look."


"We've also built a veranda of approx. 20 square metres at the end of the house," continues Marianne. This allows access from the second floor and means that we can enjoy the outdoors both upstairs and downstairs. The veranda works well as an overhang and provides shelter for the sofa set on the lower floor. We think that black laths/trellises on the roof covering provide an attractive design element, and since the railing on the patio and the windbreaks are built with black laths, the whole thing becomes consistent and recognisable."

"Windbreaks have multiple functions and are therefore a great design element in the outdoor space," says Marianne. "A windbreak obviously creates shelter, but can also break up and define zones as well as provide privacy. In our case, the retaining wall is set up with integrated benches that create an attractive environment. These can be used to sit on and are also suitable for placing plant pots and other decorative items. The benches also form part of the construction and function as reinforcement of the long wall."

"We are particularly pleased with the windbreak that is made up of trellises. It has become a visually beautiful element against the stream and the greenery at the back, and it ensures privacy very effectively. At the same time, it's airy on a hot day. It's easy to feel closed in if a windbreak is too solid."

"Small projects are often the icing on the cake," emphasises Marianne. "They can add a lot to the overall impression of the space even if these aren't the projects that take the most time. We have several projects like that – ones that take the outdoor space to the next level. For example, up on the retaining wall we've built a gazebo-like structure that can be used for hanging plants. Gradually, the climbing plants will wind their way up along the structure to create an organic, green feature. Along the retaining wall we have also built a small outdoor kitchen with shelves for herbs etc., perfect for simple meals outdoors in the garden. We've also set up a bench on the path up to the garden. With a bed of straw, bamboo and shrubs, this acts as a finishing touch to the grassy slope."





Tips for laying a patio

For the construction of a patio, we recommend that you draw up a comprehensive plan. Think carefully about how you want your outdoor space to look and feel free to use some of the tips available on talgo.no. This will ensure that you are happy with the end result and that the construction process is easier. The finish and details are often what determine how satisfied you will be with the end result. That is why these details are worth spending some time on.



HOW TO DO IT

How to lay a patio

1. Treat all cut surfaces

Remember to oil all cut surfaces with MøreRoyal Wood Oil to prevent moisture from penetrating the wood. The cut surfaces can be oiled quickly and easily with a brush or sponge.

2. Use the correct fastenings

Stainless steel A2 fastenings or acid-resistant A4 fastenings should be used on all MøreRoyal products. Always use A4 acid-resistant fastenings in maritime or salty coastal environments.

3. Use fastenings that are long enough

Check that the screws are the correct length before you start. As a rule, the screws should be about twice as long as the thickness of the materials.

4. Use fastenings with the correct spacing

Screw in 1.5-2 cm from the edge and 2.5 cm from the end/joint. If you screw in fastenings too close to the ends, the board may crack, and if you screw in fastenings too far towards the middle of the boards, the wood may warp.

5. Ensure the correct laying distance

Wooden materials will expand and shrink depending on the weather conditions. Follow the requirements for minimum distance between boards, joints and walls. Decking boards should be laid with gaps of 2-3 millimetres – use a carpenter's ruler, if possible.

6. Ensure effective air circulation

To avoid moisture, it is important to ensure good air circulation within the structure. Remember that decking boards should not be laid right up against a wall. A gap between the decking boards and the wall is required in order to allow water to drain away.

7. Ensure the correct joist spacing

The correct joist spacing in the substructure provides a stable and safe patio. Decking boards are laid on joists with a spacing of 600 millimetres. Make sure that you use joists that are dimensioned for the purpose and capable of withstanding the calculated load from snow, roof avalanches etc.

8. Joining

When joining decking boards, make sure that the boards curve in the same direction to ensure a good joint.



Planning your patio

We recommend that you make a simple diagram before you start your patio project. Think about where the best place will be to eat, where the barbecue will go, where you require privacy and where you need an overhang.

Take a look at our diagram and consider whether any of the following tips might be useful to you. Once your diagram is in place, you are already well on your way – and the job will be more fun and the end result will definitely be better. Good luck!

1. Storage

Think of places to use for storage while you are building:

- a floor hatch
- drawers in steps
- benches/boxes in ledges
- separate storage shed

With smart solutions built into the outdoor space, cleaning is a breeze and you still have everything you need within easy reach.

2. Screening

Do you need screens against wind, sunlight and rain?

- MøreRoyal windbreaks with or without glass
- windbreaks in other materials
- awnings

3. Visual effects/framing

Do you want to have different patio zones? One option is to mark these out with frames and patterns in the patio floor. Combinations of smooth/grooved sides and different board dimensions are great for framing and marking out zones, entrances, posts, steps, ledges in an attractive way. Unleash your imagination!





4. Zones


Think about different zones on your patio and how they may be suitable for different purposes according to light/shade conditions. These zones also have different requirements when it comes to privacy, views, overhangs, light and so on.

Examples of zones:

- dining area
- barbecue area
- relaxation area
- sunbathing area

5. Platforms/levels/steps

Should your patio be built on different levels? This is a great way of breaking up large areas and making the patio more inviting and exciting. Perhaps steps/level dividers could be built in as benches or storage boxes? The bigger the patio, the more advisable it is to break up any large areas.



6. Under cover

Maybe you should think about a separate gazebo which will be shelter you from the weather, ensure that you are able to sit comfortably and extend the summer season as well as allow you to have somewhere to store your garden furniture in the winter?



7. Lighting

Where is the best place to install lighting?

- on walls
- recessed in the patio
- along pathways
- on railings/windbreaks
- in plant boxes

8. Pathways

Where will paths across the patio naturally run? This is where you will see the most wear and tear so you should perhaps look at:

- reinforcement with gravel/outdoor tiles
- reinforcement with railway sleepers
- gravel as underlay for barbecue/fireplace

9. Looking in/out

When choosing screening, think about where you want to prevent anyone looking in or where you want to be able to look out.


- MøreRoyal windbreaks with or without glass
- MøreRoyal windbreaks with trellises/laths
- MøreRoyal railings or glass

10. That little bit extra

If you have a large patio, you may want to go that little bit further? How about a jacuzzi or a patio plant box built into the patio floor? This can be done in several different ways e.g. using:

- patio decking
- railways sleepers
- stones







Not far from his childhood home, Halvor Bakke has found his oasis – on a small farm in Trae near Stavern. The small farm itself originally dates back to the 1840s and was extended in 1920. Out here, Halvor has given his passion for design and interiors free rein, and the results speak for themselves. Let's take a closer look at Halvor's exciting outdoor space.

A PLACE FOR CREATIVITY TO UNFOLD

When you are a television host, a designer, an author and an ambassador for multiple brands, it is inevitable that your schedule quickly becomes packed. But Halvor Bakke has learned to give himself a breathing space for a better work-life balance, and at his home in Trae his creativity comes into its own.

"When I'm designing a new collection, there's a lot that inspires me, especially when I'm travelling. But my own creativity is best expressed when I'm wandering around here at home on the small farm in Trae," explains Halvor. "Maybe it's because this is the place where I find the most peace, where I'm able to wander around on the patio and have a coffee while listening to the birds chirping early in the morning.

HALVOR'S OUTDOOR SPACE

No one can doubt that Halvor's creativity has found a real outlet out here in the countryside. This is clear to anyone who is lucky enough to be invited inside. The garden is largely located at the back of the main building, shielded from the road that winds past on the opposite side. This means that Halvor is protected from curious passers-by who might like to get a glimpse of life inside.

"It's important to me that I can be myself out here, and fortunately most people respect that. After all, this is my home and a place that's reserved for me and my family. I've spent a lot of time both indoors and outdoors to make it just the way I dreamed of, and now I'm getting there very fast," laughs Halvor.

The surroundings testify to the fact that Halvor has created an appealing oasis for himself. The area includes a greenhouse, a spacious patio with Halvor's own outdoor furniture collection, a small pier into a carp pond, an abundant kitchen garden, a sun deck for sunworshippers, an awning for grey days and an outdoor shower that is used as soon as spring arrives.

A PIER IN THE COUNTRYSIDE

Halvor Bakke's patio has undergone an extreme transformation. Last year, the old patio was replaced with Concise patio decking in grey. Halvor has furnished a generous seating area with space for many guests, and the patio has become an ideal place for socialising. The patio ends in a small pier into the carp pond, decorated with lanterns that create a warm atmosphere when darkness descends.

"There's something about sitting down on that pier, whether I'm alone on a summer morning or with good friends late in the evening. Concise has a lovely, brushed surface so we like to wander around barefoot here and just enjoy the sight of the fish playing in the pond. It brings you absolute peace," says Halvor.



The choice of a MøreRoyal patio in grey was no coincidence either.

"I'm a big fan of MøreRoyal products. There's something about wood. It's so real, honest and natural." And since MøreRoyal's decking boards come pre-treated in several colours, the job is done when the decking is installed. No additional painting required!

"I fell for the grey decking this time because it fits in especially well here at Trae. The boards have a lovely, warm grey hue, but will eventually be affected by the weather and the ravages of time. The decking boards will grey even more over time and acquire a lovely weathered patina, and that's what I like about it the most."



A SUN DECK IN THE GARDEN EVERYONE SHOULD HAVE

In the garden, Halvor has also built a small sun deck for when temperatures start to rise. A small windbreak has also been built here. This screens off the view, but also provides a cosy nook where life can be enjoyed under the parasol.

"This is actually my favourite place, if I say so myself," admits Halvor. "I love it! Flat out on the sunbed, relaxing and being extremely happy finally to have reached the end of an all-consuming outdoor project."



A SHOWER WITH PUNCH

However, not all outdoor projects need to be that extensive. Even small projects have come into their own in Halvor's garden. Taking a shower outdoors and ensuring a refreshing start to the day is something Halvor enjoys.

"I absolutely love starting the day with an outdoor shower," says Halvor. "It's just fantastic! The wooden frame of the outdoor shower at Trae has been painted to match the house. I've also built a small area of MøreRoyal decking as these are materials that can take that little bit extra. I recommend that everyone should hone their skills on some simpler do-it-yourself projects, whether it's an outdoor shower or other projects for the garden. It gives you a feeling of accomplishment, and soon you'll be ready to tackle larger outdoor projects," he concludes confidently with a twinkle in his eye.

Cleaning and maintenance of MøreRoyal® patios

All timber requires maintenance, including MøreRoyal. However, the maintenance requirements for MøreRoyal are more infrequent and significantly simpler than for many other types of timber. This means that you can spend more time enjoying life outdoors – and less time with a broom and a roller.





WASHING

To maintain the beautiful appearance of your patio, it is important that you take good care of it. Although MøreRoyal patios are able to withstand being left untreated for many years without refreshing the oil, annual washing and cleaning is essential. Clean your patio in the spring and in the autumn.

Our tips

- 1. Use a mild domestic detergent and a hose
- **2.** Avoid grease-soluble agents and high-pressure cleaners
- **3.** Wash the patio before you perform any other maintenance

MAINTENANCE

Wear and tear

Over time, external factors will wear down all types of wood. MøreRoyal products consist of double-treated materials, and even though horizontal surfaces are worn down by the forces of nature, outdoor furniture and footfall, the oil is pressed into the wood for long-term protection. The rule of thumb is: top up with oil after 6-7 years to best preserve the properties of the materials. Whether you want to refresh the colour before that time is a matter of personal preference.

Refreshing the colour

The fact that the colours become more muted does not mean that the materials have lost their quality. The oil added during production is still there in the wood, ensuring good protection. Some people prefer the more muted and weathered look that occurs after a while, but if you want to refresh the colour, it can be done quickly and effectively by applying a coat of oil.

OIL

MøreRoyal products should be treated with MøreRoyal oils – with or without colour pigments.

Remember to apply MøreRoyal Wood Oil in the same colour as the materials on all cut surfaces during construction to ensure quality and appearance. Using our own maintenance products is a condition of the warranty.


Which colour should I choose?

MøreRoyal oil is available in all MøreRoyal colours. If you want to refresh the colour of the materials, we recommend using clear oil. It is also possible to use coloured oil. This will give a deeper colour than the original colour of the materials. This choice is completely up to you!
